MAKING AN APPLICATION FOR YOUR COURSE AFTER YEAR 11

Over the next few months, you will be thinking about your options after Year 11 and starting to submit your applications. Most students will apply by Christmas. If you are unsure between a few courses, you can apply for more than one and make a decision after you receive your GCSE results in August.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I APPLY?

Once you submit an application, you will be contacted by our Enrolment Team to arrange an interview with you and the course leader. This will give you the opportunity to ask the lecturers any questions you may have about the course and discuss your decision to choose the course, as well as your career aspirations.

If you meet the entry requirements, you will be made a conditional offer, which you can accept, and this will provide you with a place on the course. Once you have a place, there is nothing more you need to do until after you receive your GCSE results.

You will then attend an Enrolment Day at the end of August or the start of September, where you will collect your lanyard and complete your final steps to become a Petroc student.









FINDING AN APPRENTICESHIP

As you begin thinking about your next steps, you may be considering the idea of an apprenticeship. Apprenticeships are a great option if you enjoy a more practical way of learning and are keen to start earning a salary straight after leaving school. There are many apprenticeships available in a variety of subjects, so if you are certain about your career path, this could be the route for you. It can sometimes be difficult to find an employer to complete your apprenticeship with, so here are some tips for finding an apprenticeship:

- Ensure you produce an up-to-date CV; this is the first thing an employer will see. (Include any work experience, part-time jobs, or achievements you have.)
- Ensure you make contact with the employer directly and do not leave it to your parent or guardian. Employers like to see confidence and initiative.
- Do not be disheartened if you do not hear back straight away. Follow up a few weeks after enquiring.
- Research the company to ensure you know a bit about their values and what underpins the business.
