Tottenham Hotspurs Football Experience – Saturday 14th March 2026

I am delighted to be offering a new football experience for students, taking place on Saturday 14th March. This one-day trip will replace the original residential football trip that was due to take place earlier in the academic year.

The day will begin with a stadium tour of the Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, offering students a behind-the-scenes look at one of the newest football venues in the UK. Following the tour, we will travel to watch the Premier League fixture: West Ham United vs Manchester City, promising an unforgettable live football experience.

The total cost of the trip will be £195, which includes travel, stadium tour, match ticket, and supervision.

To secure a place, a £45 non-refundable deposit will be required by 9.00 am on Wednesday 19th November.

We are hoping this trip will be extremely popular, so places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis once deposits are received.

The remaining balance of £150 will be due by 9.00 am on Friday 9th January 2026.

Further details regarding timings, travel arrangements, and what students will need to bring will be shared closer to the date.
